ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT - Executive Director & Administrative Services Manager

The state grants have been delayed, but we are working on getting the reimbursement. We have a port security grant that we are working on that would integrate the gate system with the scale system and automate reports to the accounting department for billing purposes. We are continuing to scan and archive our records. We are hoping to have a dedicated ship this year for our aluminum shipments. We recently met with CSX which has increased their rail deliveries to Novelis. We continue to work on collecting the outstanding marina invoices. The port has secured the storing of the American Fortitude freighter for the winter. The freighter which was built in 1953 and is 690 feet long is headed to Texas where it will be scrapped. We have requested a request to MARAD, which was granted, for an extension to complete the east Connector Project/Rail Projects that were delayed due to weather in 2014. We located and purchased three light towers and one heavy trailer from the Federal Suplus program. The purchase of the light towers has eliminated the monthly rental expense. We have prepared a Master Goal Plant to submit to the Director of the Division of Minority and Woman's Business Development as required by New York State Executive Law Article 15-A. The NYS WMBE requirements are 20%, but will be raising it to 30%. We have completed the Domestic Violence in the Workplace Bi-Annual Report.

CHAIRMAN

The New York State ABO has informed us that all training has been completed. The annual report for the Joint Commission of Public Ethics is due in February and board member financial disclosure forms are due May. An infrastructure study has just been released that shows the investment that has been made in the Canadian and US ports and seaway.
