The Port of Oswego Authority is a public benefit agency of the State of New York created by the New York Legislature (Public Authorities Law Article 6) entrusted with the task of conducting marine terminal and intermodal operations on Lake Ontario/Central New York. The Port of Oswego also serves as an economic catalyst for New York State.
