

Report of Operations
Port of Oswego Authority
FY 2021-2022

The Port of Oswego serves as a critical transportation link in Central New York by providing cargo handling operations for more than twenty companies seeking domestic and international shipment of their products. While providing world class services, the Port continues to play a vital role in the economic development initiatives of the region.

Total operating revenues of the Port increased by \$57,374 which is attributable to an uptick in business (aluminum and project cargo) and the Anderson grain contract.

The total net position of the Port increased by 147 percent (\$23,048,936 in 2022 compared to \$9,323,586 in 2021). This is due to the large ongoing grant construction projects.

Total expenses increased by 6 percent (\$4,538,636 in 2022 compared to \$4,270,175 in 2021). This increase directly related to a business increase realized by the Port.

The Port of Oswego received the Robert J. Lewis Pacesetter Award from the U.S. Great Lakes St. Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation in 2021 due to increase in international traffic.

The Port of Oswego will continue to serve as a multimodal operation, assisting companies in meeting their logistics solutions. With a dedicated staff and an unsurpassed longshoremen crew, the Port stands poised to provide the highest level of customer service and continue as a member of the economic development continuum for Oswego County and Central New York.
